COVID-19 Precautions: In Person Worship Update to Maintain Health & Safety

After careful consideration of multiple sources, including the CDC, NC State guidelines, Forsyth County Health Dept. as well as Provincial recommendations, and much prayer, the Joint Boards of CMC have set Sunday, August 9th as the tentative target date to resume in person worship services in the sanctuary of the church.

Several criteria will have to be met in the interim and our reopening task force which was formed in May of this year will have policy and procedures for everyone to follow as noted below.

As we move towards this regathering there may be churches in our area that will choose to open back sooner and maybe some later; however, the Joint Boards have first and foremost considered the safety of each one of our members in selecting this time frame.

We thank you for your patience and continued support during this time and ask that you continue to pray for healing for all those who are sick and continued guidance for the church as we move forward towards

re-establishing our normal operating environment. The main objective of the task force was to construct the safest way to begin holding in person worship services, and the following procedures were approved by the Joint Boards:

Half of the congregation will be assigned to attend worship in person on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month while the other half attends on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of the month.

Everyone entering the church must wear a mask.

Our Sunday morning worship services will continue to be broadcast live via our Facebook and broadcast on WTOB radio 980 AM & 96.3 FM so that everyone can participate by watching from home.
