Discover Your Gifts: A Stewardship 365 Experience for Deepening and Strengthening Our Perception.

In our annual journey through the 50 days of Easter, from Easter Dawn til Pentecost, we are invited to dig into what the baptismal promise, "therefore live, yet not you alone, but Christ live in you," means for practicing resurrection. We hear the texts like Acts 4:32-35 that tell about the community of believers being one in heart and mind and holding everything in common for the good of all - sharing as any were in need. These texts ask us to take seriously the value of the spiritual gifts entrusted to us as we embrace the ways Christ lives in each of us. Our baptism and life as disciples calls us to consider and cultivate the ways we can steward well what has been entrusted to us - both as individuals and in community.

At the conclusion of the online survey, your score will be tallied and results offered for each of the 20 spiritual gifts included in this tool - you can have this emailed to you. You can also complete the assessment survey through the paper version that is available sometime in the vestibule or Church Office. Simply follow the instructions included with this printed version and bring it with you on the evening of May 8th.

Detailed instructions that could be helpful when filling out the online survey:

- 1. Before May 8, follow link or pick up paper form and complete survey.
- 2. If using link, once you reach final tally screen, please capture your results in one of the following ways;
 - a. Selecting Print option from your browser and print a copy
- b. Writing down the 3 gifts with your highest score (there are 20 gift categories)
- c. Entering your email address where requested on the results page, then click submit for it to be emailed to you
- d. Only use "Email to yourself" option. Do Not use "Email to Someone Else".

Using what you have discovered through this assessment survey, we'll explore more about these spiritual gifts through scripture study, small group discussion, and take a look at how the variety of perceptions we each bring to our life as disciples has the power to strengthen the ministry we can be stewards of together!
