What's in the gardens?

I am writing this on March 6. The gardens look a little drab right now but there are things in those dead-looking stems and under the leaves and mulch that are very much alive. Some beneficial insects insert their eggs into the stems of wildflowers and grasses for safe keeping over the winter. Larger stems provide excellent places for cavity nesting insects. The availability of nesting and overwintering habitat is one of the most important factors influencing populations of native bees and other beneficial insects. This is why we wait until late winter/ early spring to cut back the flowering shrubs, grasses and other plants in the gardens.
