Easton Elementary School

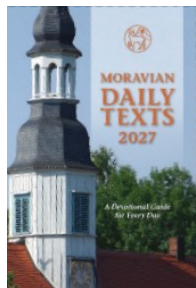
Final week of collecting school items for the start of the 2026-2027 year. School supplies for the students have to be delivered by the beginning of August!
