It is all about Jesus. And it is all about those whom we serve. And it is about us, too.

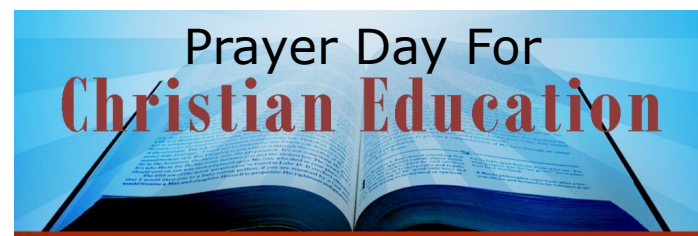
**God’s love is shown to us through the three persons of the holy Trinity. We are welcomed into that relationship as those who love and as those who are beloved. Thanks be to God!**
